1104 **ל** (הל *HL*) AC: Shine CO: Star AB: Distant: The pictograph **ל** is a picture of a man with his arms raised looking at a great sight. The **ל** is a shepherd staff representing the idea of "toward" as the staff is used to move a sheep toward a direction. Combined these letters mean "a looking toward something" such as the looking toward a light in the distance. The stars have always been used to guide the traveler or shepherd to find his home or destination.

A) ל (הל *HL*) AC: Look CO: ? AB: ?: To look toward a sight.

ל (הל *HL*) - I. These: Designating a group that is with the speaker. In the sense of looking toward a sight. [Hebrew and Aramaic; The short form " **ל** " is used as a prefix meaning "look" and translated as "the".] [df: la hla] **ל**. Toward: A moving to or toward something to be with it as the ox moves toward a destination. [df: la] **ל** **KJV** (69): these, those, this, thus, who, so, such, some, same, other, which, another, whom, they, them - **Strong's**: H411 (ל), H412 (ל), H413 (ל), H428 (ל), H429 (ל)

ל (היל *HYL*) - These: Designating a group that is with the speaker. In the sense of looking toward a sight. [Aramaic only] [df: lla] **ל** **KJV** (14): these, those - **Strong's**: H479 (ל)

ל (תלהל *THLH*) - Folly: In the sense of shining. **ל** **KJV** (1): folly - **Strong's**: H8417 (תלהל)
